Balmain Public School Swimming Carnival – On Friday, 8 February 2019

Dear Parents and Carers,

The Balmain Public School Swimming Carnival will be held on Friday, 8 February 2019 at Drummoyne Aquatic Centre.

Please note: it is an OUTDOOR POOL – so although the grand stand has shade, **ALL students** are required to wear a hat and will be encouraged to wear sunscreen. Teachers will have sunscreen available on the day, for student use.

Attendance is compulsory for ALL students in Years 3-6. Any students in Year 2, who are 8 or turning 8 in 2019, are invited to participate. The carnival will proceed regardless of weather conditions and transport will be by bus. All students are required to be at school no later than 8:50 am for class roll call.

The total cost of the activity is calculated by dividing the cost of pool hire and transport by the number of students who are expected to participate. Therefore the cost for each student is the same whether or not they travel by bus. Spectators are most welcome on the day, however will be required to pay entry into the pool (\$3.90). If you are available to assist on the day, it would be greatly appreciated. Miss Sarah Weston will be allocating roles on the day.

Please note: Ribbons will be awarded to students, who place 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th in the final, or 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th overall in the heats (where no final has taken place). Place ribbons will not be distributed for individual heats.

The NSW Supplementary Sporting Injury Benefits Scheme, funded by the NSW Government, provides limited cover for serious injury resulting in the permanent loss of a prescribed faculty of the use of some prescribed part of the body.
