








PEP is an annual program for Yr5 students who show ability in a particular area.

It is held at Sydney Secondary College, Balmain Campus.






The 2014 theme was 'Outside the Box'.

Mr. Corbett, a SSCBC mathematics teacher planned a treasure hunt. Students had to use 3D co-ordinate geometry to locate the treasure.






The science elective were given a choice of scientific concepts to investigate. One group chose to explore the feasibility of time travel.




