Saturday saw an event bag and bib stuffing day at the Fosters'. There were 20 adults and an assortment of kids, stuffing 1000




event bags, packing 1800 bibs and 7200 safety pins, as well as bagging up 133 t-shirts/caps.

Fundraising to support Aidan Brown

As a part of our Giving Tree Assembly, we would also like to acknowledge Aidan Brown, a little boy from Annandale North Public School with an ex-

tremely rare form of cancer. He was diagnosed with Adrenocortical Carcinoma (cancer of the adrenal gland) in March this year. This cancer affects as few as one in a million Australian adults and even fewer children; the Browns are unaware of another child suffering from this disease in the country. Its rarity makes the cancer difficult to treat. After eight months of intensive chemotherapy and drug therapy, Aidan's tumours have reduced, but still remain. As you can imagine, the lives of his family have been turned upside down.

A group of parents in the local community has banded together to raise funds for the Browns to enable Aidan's parents, Rob and Dawn, to be with Aidan while he battles adrenocortical carcinoma. The funds will also be used to assist in the next phase of treatment and quality time with the family. They have set up a website <u>www.aidansquest.com.au</u> and Facebook page (Aidan's Quest) in the hope of raising \$30,000 in 30 days. Balmain Public School will be hosting a gold coin donation during the assembly to help contribute towards this fund.

OUR BIG KITCHEN...



Under the inspiration and organisation of Ms Bird, 6B, 5/6N & 5L volunteered our time at *Our Big Kitchen*. Across our stage, we have been looking at members of our society that do not have a voice. We have also explored ideas of democracy and equality. *Our Big Kitchen* was the perfect opportunity for our students to put their learning into practice.

The idea to start OBK was based on an experience that the founders had with a woman in the community who was extremely unwell. This lady was working with the founders and the burden of providing her and her family with meals fell onto the families in the community. The founders decided to do some communal cooking for her. To do this, they borrowed a kitchen and got together a group of volunteers to cook.





During these cook—ins, they noticed that the electricity that was created in that borrowed kitchen amongst the people there was incredible. Then and there they realised that this was something that they wanted to duplicate to help others in the community in need. They also wanted to bring together other people to share in this experience. So they transformed the basement in Bondi into a large-scale industrial kitchen that is now used to benefit anyone in the community.

OUR BIG KITCHEN...



On any given day the kitchen is caters for the homeless, refugees, hospitalised, families in need, you name it! We also learnt that they work to rehabilitate people through teaching basic hospitality skills, in order to give them a second chance. During our visit, the students were making biscuits for children in hospital. They also helped to make their own lunch, including their own bread rolls!


