

We've also been making beautiful art works with Miss Fitzgerald in the Art Studio.

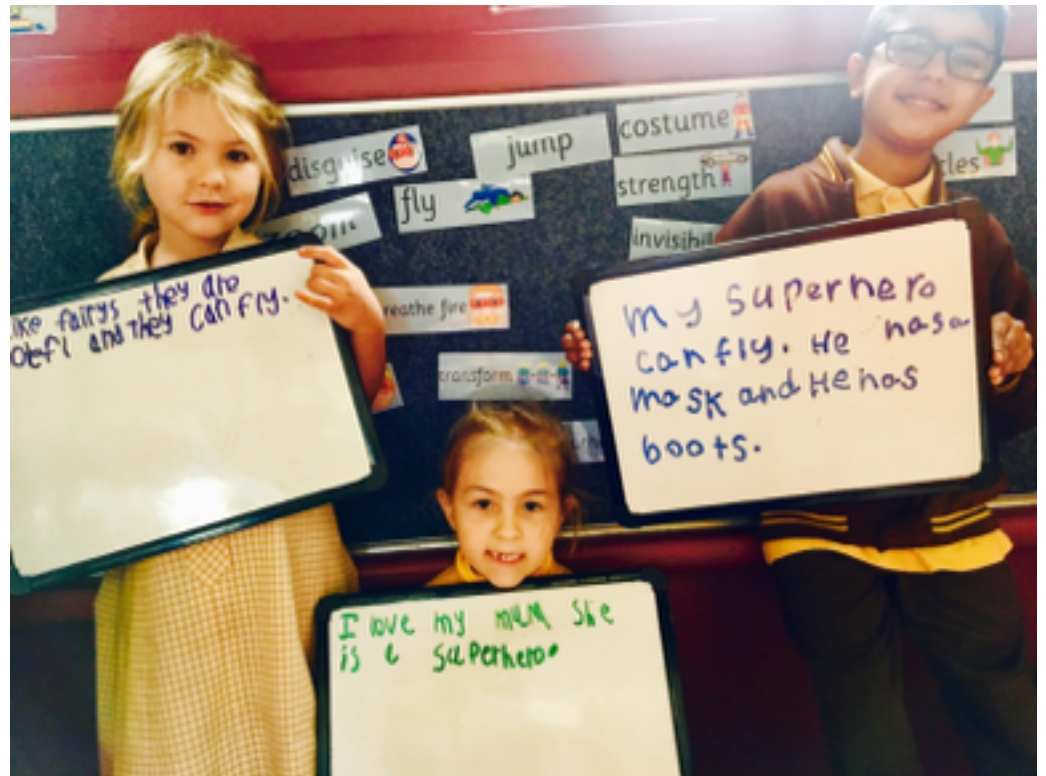




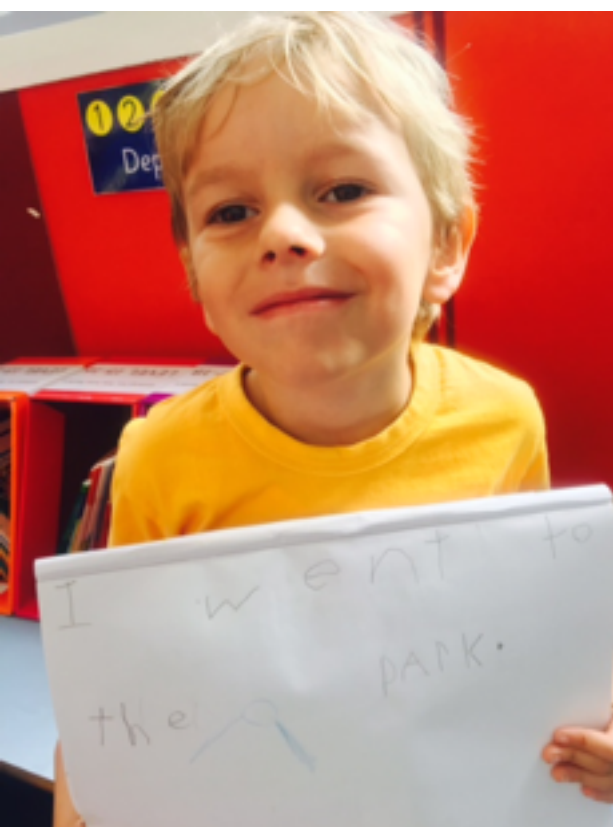
# Writing, writing, writing!

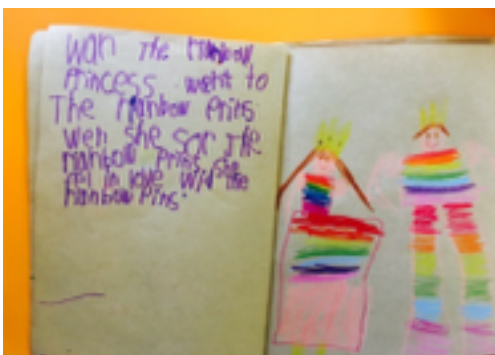


...and Miss Parsons can't believe how beautiful our writing books look! We use 'safety circles' if we make a mistake, so we can be brave and take risks with our writing.
